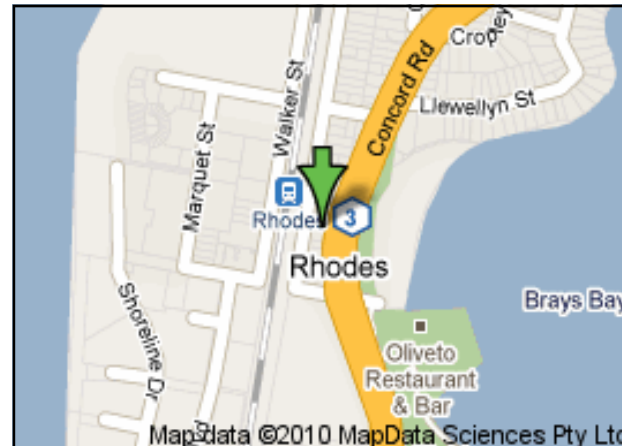

WHAT IS GROUP SUPERVISION?

Group Supervision is a group program run by The Salvation Army Counselling Service in Rhodes. The aim of this program is to provide support and assistance to counsellors, at an affordable cost.

WHAT WE DO

The purpose of this group is to give counsellors the opportunity to gain further knowledge, skills and support, as well as to assist in maintaining their ethical and professional standards.

We provide a place of growth for counsellors in a safe environment, and where appropriate an opportunity for them to be challenged in a positive and respectful way.

Confidentiality and privacy is maintained at all times.

HOW BIG IS THE GROUP?

There is a minimum of 4 and a maximum of 6 supervisees in a group.

SUPERVISOR

The group will be led by a professional Relationship Counsellor who is also a qualified supervisor. She is committed to giving the highest quality care.

OUR OBJECTIVES

- To journey together and encourage supervisees to work more effectively and creatively with their couple clients
- To explore different ways in working with difficult couples
- To support counsellors working with couples, whose spouse has experienced trauma, abuse or mental disorder
- To explore ways in identifying Domestic Violence in the couple relationship and how to work and manage this type of case
- How to identify and work with different types of couple relationships, such as co-dependent, independent, etc.
- To encourage and promote different levels of reflection and create awareness on supervisees' work with their couples, through constructive feedback that facilitates change for supervisees, which will be of benefit to their clients
- To help supervisees think systemically and stay focused with their couple work
- To help supervisees develop ethical maturity

APPROACH

A variety of verbal, creative and experiential approaches will be used throughout the supervisory process.

- Verbal—through dialogue.
- Creative—sandplay, symbols, pillows, art, etc.

The group will meet on a monthly basis, for a 2 hour session. There will be a total of 10 sessions in a calendar year. It is anticipated that the group will commence in Oct 2011.

\$55 per person per (2 hour) session.
